

Presentation to Judge's Panel

Form introduction

The participants are expected to enter the competition area and introduce themselves to the judges as they start their performance. This needs to be practiced in a loud confident voice to be heard over a noisy environment.

The entry and introduction are as follows:

- When the participant is called by name, they should stand quickly, turn around (face away from the judges) and adjust their uniform, turn around, bow to the mat, then walk quickly towards the judges.
- When they are in front of the judges, come to attention, bow to the judges, then go into a strong ready stance.
- Verbal Introduction (LOUD VOICE)
"Judges, my name is _____! I practice Tang Soo Do with Master Mendivil! I am going to perform the form _____. May I proceed!"
- The competitor will then wait for a response (a nod or a yes), go to attention position and bow to the judges, then walk backward away from the judges (always facing the judges) to the edge of the mat.
- Then go into a ready stance and begin the form when they are ready.
- When they finish the form, return to ready, attention position, bow to the judges, and wait to be dismissed.
